Sphinx Moths in the Nova Scotia Museum Collection

(Lepidoptera: Sphingidae)

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INTRODUCTION

Sphinx moths are large, streamlined, fast flying moths, many of which are active around flowers at dusk. Some species are day fliers and a few are most active at night. The caterpillars are usually green with oblique stripes on the sides and have a small horn-like tail.

The sphingid collection comprises 1,174 specimens representing 97 species, 26 of which are found in Nova Scotia. 80% of the specimens are spread and housed in glass topped drawers in Lane cabinets, the remaining 20% are pinned and stored in Schmidt boxes.

The Lepidoptera collection is one of the major collections of its kind in Canada, possibly being second only to the Canadian National Collection in Ottawa. It is particularly strong in Microlepidoptera, but has fair representation in the Macrolepidoptera. Larger species such as the sphingids are not well represented due primarily to their bulk and the limited storage space available. Although many sections of the Lepidoptera collection have been the subject of taxonomic research the sphingids have not. This is probably due to there being no species or subspecies in this family which are confined to this province or region. Seven species are southern and occasionally stray north to Nova Scotia. Two species are northern and although they probably breed here are rarely collected. The remaining

seventeen species are widely distributed in North America.

Since the publication of the sphingid fascicle of "The Moths of America north of Mexico" in January 1971, the collection has been reorganized and a catalog prepared by Ken Neil. This report is based on that catalog.
