The Myers Family of Jeddore

INTRODUCTION

The following history of the Myers family of Jeddore was prepared to provide background information which could assist the interpretation program at the Fisherman's Life Museum. The history was compiled from public records, church records, cemeteries, and from a conversation I had a number of years ago with Mrs. Clyde Siteman. The information is nowhere near complete. I have not had the time or the knowledge to include present generations, and so the information is limited to what is publicly available.

I have used a system which I prefer, but which is not necessarily genealogically correct. I have given everyone a number, starting with the first in the area, and then followed through each male line as far as possible. Thus all the descendants of Andrew (2) are listed before the descendants of John Henry (3), etc. The list of names in brackets indicates lieage, and the little number above indicates generation. In some cases, I could only guess, so, for example, #75 John B. Myers, born about 1884, was the son of John, grandson of Henry, maybe the great-grandson of Andrew, and great-grandson of the first Andrew.

THE MYERS FAMILY OF JEDDORE

1. Andrew Myers married Mary . Came as a Loyalist to Ship Harbour in the 1780s from the 96th District, South Carolina. Did not receive a formal land grant.

Other Myers names from this period include Jacob, a baker, of Halifax who was a suretie for the marriage bond of George Shelnutt, widower, of Ship Harbour, July 14, 1819; Catherine Myers, married Henry Falkirk, Nov. 25, 1813, marriage bond signed by John and Henry Myers, both of Jeddore.

2. Andrew² (Andrew ') married after 1832, Eliza Webber, daughter of Peter (d. 1832) and Elizabeth (Merryweather). The will of Peter Webber of Egmont Harbour in Jeddore refers to his daughter Eliza or Elizabeth as "who pleased God to inflict", so perhaps she was disabled in some way. Andrew and his brother William married sisters.

5. Elizabeth, born c. 1835, married twice, first Jamieson, second her cousin James H. Myers (#145)

I can't be certain about any other children of Andrew and Eliza, however there are a number of Myers in Jeddore who were of this generation. As I know nothing of their ancestry, I am guessing that they might fit in here. For example, it is logical for Andrew to have a son named Peter for his wife's father (who died in 1832).

- 9. James L. (Peter³,?Andrew², Andrew¹), blacksmith at Jeddore Head, married Agripina Baker, daughter of Daniel and Agnes, a fisherman from Jeddore West, October 19, 1880

O.P. had the store at Jeddore Head, and he died in 1942.





John Henry Myers of Jeddore died intestate in November 1859. Although his estate was not valued at more than L100, he had an interest with his son Colin in the schooner "Conservative" of Halifax (each owned 1/2 share).

A Barbara Shelnut, age 13, is listed in the Ship Harbour school register, November 1839, so she was born about 1826. Colin was a farmer and fisherman at

Jeddore-Myers Point.



4. William (Andrew) married December 24, 1824, Mary Webber, daughter of Peter (d. 1832) and Elizabeth (Merryweather). William and his brother Andrew both married sisters. This William is believed to be the first Myers at Oyster Ponds. It is also possible and logical for William to have had a son Peter, named for his father-in-law who died in 1832. This is only a guess. Peter Webber left an interesting bequest to Mary in his will: "I also give and bequeath to my beloved daughter mary Myers the cast iron stove and funnell which now stands in the house I occupy..." (Feb. 20, 1832) Did Mary ever bring this stove to Oyster Pond?

A problem I have yet to straighten out concerns a gravestone at Jeddore for Isabella Sarah Myers, died 1884 aged 73, and William Myers, died 1880 aged 70. This William was a miller, and his will mentions his son Peter, his daughter Isabella Smith, and his late daughter Susan Mitchell. As Peter Myers (#6 above) had a daughter, Isabella S., born c. 1859, it is possible that this Peter was the son of William, and not of Andrew. Or did this William represent another Myers family altogether?
