

THE FISH COLLECTION OF THE NOVA SCOTIA MUSEUM

The fish collection of the Nova Scotia Museum began with a few dried foreign species in the Old Mechanics' Institute Museum of 1831-68.

The collection of Nova Scotian fishes was founded upon that of about 22 nominal species collected and prepared by John Matthew Jones, F. L. S., of the Nova Scotia Commission for the International Exhibition in London in 1862. This collection was also exhibited in Paris at the Exposition Universelle in 1867, and was placed in the Provincial Museum in 1868.

Dr. Honeyman, in his first report of the Provincial Museum, 1872, pp. 81-82, listed 24 nominal species in the alcohol collection of Nova Scotia fishes.

A number of very interesting specimens, distinguished by a numbered metal tag, were presented to the Museum in 1877 by the United States Fisheries Commission. They were collected in the Halifax area by the U. S. Fish Commission Steam Tug Speedwell

while she was stationed at Halifax from August 27 to October 13, 1877.

Other specimens were added from time to time, particularly during the Great International Fisheries Exhibition, London, in 1883, when the collection was again shown under the supervision of Dr. Honeyman.

This information was gathered from notes made by Harry Piers, former Curator of the Museum; he stated that the collection consisted of 83 species of dry and alcoholic specimens of Nova Scotian fishes in 1917.

There was no concerted effort to make this collection a useful and comprehensive one until 1948 when D. A. Livingstone, a postgraduate student at Dalhousie University, was employed by the Museum for the purpose of building a representative collection of the freshwater fishes of Nova Scotia. This collection was deposited with the Museum in 1950. Included were a few samples of freshwater fish taken during the Nova Scotia Inland Fisheries Survey in 1946.

J. L. Martin, museum biologist, organized and catalogued the entire collection between 1950 and 1954.

During the summer of 1955 Francis R. Cook and John S. Erskine investigated the freshwater fishes of Nova Scotia. Collections

from the mainland added greatly to the existing freshwater material. Five new localities for the eastern blacknose dace, ~~gobies~~, Rhinichthys atratulus (Hermann), were discovered and one collection from Atkinson Brook, Cumberland Co., N. S., was the first record for this species from the Bay of Fundy drainage basin ~~complet-~~ (Cook, 1961. Canadian Field Naturalist. 75: 1. pp. 51-52) ~~10~~

From the spring of 1964 to the present time John and Michael Gilhen and John Chapman have contributed species not already represented in the collection. The most interesting was the second collection of striped mullet, Mugil cephalus Linnaeus, from inshore Canadian waters (Gilhen, in press).

John Owen Kiley and Victor Kiley, fishermen from Prospect, Halifax Co., have also contributed specimens in recent years, including a ghost fish, Cryptacanthodes maculatus Storer, one bluefish, Pomatomus saltatrix (Linnaeus), a blue runner, Caranx cryos (Mitchill) and an atlantic menhaden, Brevoortia tyrannus (Latrobe).

Since 1966 a small number of fish from the Department of Fisheries frozen fish display at the annual Lunenburg Exhibition have been incorporated into the collection.

A small quantity of reference material bearing Royal Ontario Museum and National Museum labels are included in the collection.

Until 1965 most of the fish were preserved in alcohol or formalin, stored in glass jars and kept in glass-fronted cabinets. Some jars were unsuitable and in many cases specimens were packed into their jars with insufficient preservative.

During the past three years, the collection has been completely overhauled and arranged in taxonomic order on shelves in a room reserved for wet collections. New jars with bakelite screw caps were used and the preservative was changed to 50% isopropyl alcohol. The catalogue has been brought up to date.

The museum fish collection at this time consists of 93 species represented by more than 11,500 specimens. The following is a list of species including localities, dates and number of specimens per sample.
