# Films and Comics

Graphic novels and comic books, as a notoriously popular media, are often adopted by the film industry. The panel layout of comics makes conversion into storyboards simple, and the stories are short enough for a feature film. For the Young Adult Librarian, this is convenient. Cut down your collection development time by considering the purchase of both the graphic novels and the films.

Keeping an ear open for up-and-coming films is as important as keeping tabs on catalogues. The following websites are portals and listings of movie news and comic book news. Specifically, most of these websites are focused on movies based on comic books, offering news of all levels of production and distribution.

### http://www.imdb.com/

The Internet Movie Database is the essential web-guide for film information. International in range and with a scope dating to the beginning of the film and television

industries, IMDB offers most the information a person could need.

# http://comicscontinuum.com/

The Comics Continuum has a daily update of everything comic book. It is laden with unrelated advertisements, but the simple design makes for quick scanning. The site covers comic book titles, films (proposed, in production, or newly released), cartoons, and toys.

### http://www.comicbookresources.com/

Comic Book Resources is essentially an online newspaper of comic book news. Columns and regular supplements make searching discussion easy. Of particular note, the section 'The Comic Reel' covers movie news, including links to the sources.

# http://www.superherohype.com/

Superhero Hype is focused on film conversions, but does include information on other media. The fact that this site regularly accepts blogs as news makes the content questionable but entertaining.

# http://www.comicbookmovie.com/

The Comic Book Movies website has a sleek and unique layout; news about upcoming films is listed alphabetically by the character's name. This

site does include information about cartoons, and excludes films whose subject is of comics. Otherwise, a valuable site for the fan.

# http://www.comics2film.com/

Comics-to-Film contains essentially the same news as any of the above. It is a bit of an eye and brain strain to find pertinent information.

There are a number of bulletin boards, Blogs, and fan sites linked from this page; these may be useful, but otherwise the site is redundant.
