
25 DIY Craft Ideas for in the Library


1. Phone case decoration:

2. Duct tape projects:

a) Braided bead chain necklace:

For this project you'll need some specialized items such as a small loop chain, glass beads, 3mm double cup connector, 7mm jump rings, bead thread, 3 in 1 combination tool. The assembly is easy once you have gathered all of the required supplies! The final product is a trendy, practical necklace. b) Wire knot ring:
